Scholarships and Freeships provided by the Institution

(1) Ananda Chandra Sarmah Memorial Scholarship:

Ananda Chandra Sarmah Memorial Scholarship is given to the Best Graduate of the College. The student is awarded with a Certificate and Rs.5000/- on the Foundation Day of the College. Late Ananda Sarmah was the founder teacher of the English Department of our College. His family constituted a trust in his name which awards every year the best graduate of the College.

(2) Jintumoni Phukan Memorial Best Student Award:

A Certificate and Rs.2500/- is given to the Best Student of the College (one male, one female) in recognition of their all-round performances in both academic and contribution to the Corporate life of the college, on the Foundation Day of the College. Late Jintumoni Phukan, Assistant Professor, was from the Department of Political Science of our College. This award is finalised by the IQAC and College Authority, after receiving inputs from all Departments.

(3) Best Library User

This Award is given to a student who makes the best use of the Library. A certificate and a gift are awarded as a token of appreciation on the Foundation Day of the College.

(4) Madhurjya Borah Memorial Award

This Award is given every year to a student of Higher Secondary Final Year student for securing highest marks in the Final Examination. The Teachers' Unit takes the responsibility of conferring this awardon the Foundation Day of the College. Late Madhurjya Borah was Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science of our College.



(5) Dr. Ranjit Ranja Saikia Educational Scholarship

C. K. B. College, Teok has a special scholarship named "Dr. Ranjit Ranjan Saika Educational Scholarship" which is given to the Best Graduate from The Department of History. This scholarship scheme was started in the year 2020. The award of Rs.10, 000/is offered by the family of Late Dr. Ranjit Ranjan Saikia, who was Associate Professor, Department of History of our College.It is awarded on the day of organizing a Memorial Lecture in his honour.

(6) Keshab Hazarika Educational Scholarship

C.K.B. College, Teok has a Special Scholarship named "Keshab Hazarika Educational Scholarship" which was started in the Academic year 2019-2020. This scholarship is given in two parts:
